- 13 States 'A' and 'B' are state parties to the Refugee Convention 1951 as well as its protocol of 1966. Some citizens of state 'A' were being harassed and persecuted by the government of state 'A'. These citizens escaped from state 'A' and approached the government of state B requesting for refugee status. Discuss the legal position under international law.
- 14 The government of state 'X' which is engaged in war with state 'Y' started recruiting children to serve in the armed forces. Examine the legal position with regard to children under international human rights law.
- 15 Person 'A' attacks and kills another person 'B'. Examine the legal position with regard to violation of human right of 'B'.
- 16 Two persons 'X' and 'Y' enter into a contract to perform certain obligations. Subsequently 'X' commits breach of contract and 'Y' enforces his right in a court of law. 'X' is found guilty and is imprisoned. Examine the legal rights of 'X' under human rights law.
